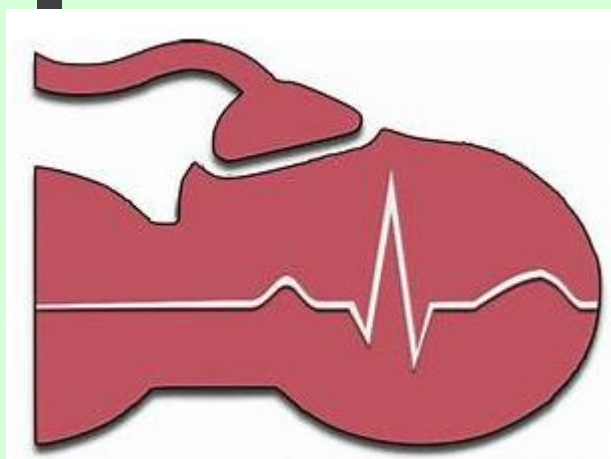

# HLT57915 Diploma Anaesthetic Technology

This qualification reflects the role of Anaesthetic Technicians who work in consultation with, and under the direction of, anaesthetists, during the induction, maintenance and emergence phases of anaesthesia.

## COURSE DETAILS

This pilot TAFE NSW course which will commence in semester 1, 2019 is aimed at existing workers in the anaesthetic field.

Learners will undertake training and assessment in the workplace and gain recognition for prior learning.
